**WORK ENVIRONMENT:** This is a check off list with a comments section for employer work environment documentation. Attach as part of the job documentation. How much exposure to environmental conditions does the job require? Wet or humid conditions (non-weather); working near moving mechanical parts; working in high, precarious places; fumes or airborne particles; toxic or caustic chemicals; outdoor weather conditions, etc. How much noise is typical for the work environment for the job? i.e., very quiet; quiet; moderate noise; loud noise; and very loud. Exposure to bloodborne pathogens that requires use of personal protective equipment. Use the chart below for your description of work environment.
